1 Forming and Pronouncing Plurals / Formación y pronunciación de plurales

Most English nouns add -s: cat → cats, cup → cups. Words ending in s, sh, ch, x, z, ge add -es: bus → buses, watch → watches. Some are irregular: man → men, child → children.

Pronunciation rules:

/s/ – voiceless (cats, cups, rocks)

/z/ – voiced (dogs, cars, clouds)

/ z/ – after s, sh, ch, x, z, ge (buses, watches, messages)
